

## CHILD FLU VACCINATIONS 2020-21

Child's Age	Where to have the Flu vaccine
<b>From 6 months until 2 years</b> (with long-term condition)	<b>GP Surgery</b>
<b>From 2 years until child starts primary school</b> (born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2018)	<b>GP Surgery</b>
<b>All children at primary school</b>	<b>School</b> <b>(Only if your child has a long-term health condition can you have this done at a GP Surgery)</b>
<b>All year 7 school children</b>	<b>School</b> <b>(Only if your child has a long-term health condition can you have this done at a GP Surgery)</b>
<b>Children aged 12 to 17 years</b> (with long-term condition)	<b>GP Surgery</b>
<b>Home-schooled children</b> (aged 4 to 11 years)	<b>Community Clinic</b> <b>(if the clinic does not contact you, ask your child's GP where to go for vaccination)</b>
